Reducing Transport Impacts

We seek to reduce the use of energy by the following:

- All new company cars to be diesel
- Telephone conferencing whenever possible
- Operating a car sharing policy when visiting clients
- Use of trains for longer travel distances within the UK and Northern Europe
- For short journeys walking/public transport is encouraged, if appropriate.
- Ride to work scheme to encourage cycling to work where appropriate.

Material Use

We aim to reduce the impact of our activities on the environment, by striving to reduce the amount of energy and materials used, by reusing materials and recycling waste products where practical. Recently, new energy efficient light fittings and high efficiency heat pumps have been installed at our Corby office. More than 65% of our waste by volume is paper, which is recycled under a local authority scheme.
